



PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy describes how we, M-U-T-Engineering GmbH A-3430 Tulln, Grottenthalgasse 33 (hereinafter referred to as "MUT"), which is responsible for data processing, collect, store and process information about individual visitors to this website.

This privacy policy applies only to MUT websites on which this privacy policy is deposited or from which this privacy policy is referred to by means of a link. This Privacy Policy does not apply to websites and apps that are not owned and controlled by MUT.

1 COMMITMENT TO DATA PROTECTION

Personal data is any information about personal or factual circumstances that relates to an identified or identifiable person. These are, for example: Your name, date of birth, email address, mailing address, or phone number. Personal data, on the other hand, is not information of a general nature that cannot be used to establish your identity.

As a general rule, we will only use your personal data in accordance with the applicable data protection laws, in particular the European General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), and only as described in this Privacy Policy. However, we reserve the right to make additional uses of this data as permitted or required by law or as necessary to support legal or criminal investigations. In this case, we will inform you again about this further data processing, if required by law.

2 ACCESS DATA

We, the website operator or page provider, collect data about access to the website on the basis of our legitimate interest (see Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f. GDPR) and store them as "server log files" on the website's server. The following data is logged in this way:

- Website visited
- Time at the time of access
- Amount of data sent in bytes
- Source/reference from which you came to the page
- Browser used
- Operating system used
- IP address used

The server log files are stored for a maximum of 7 days and then deleted. The data is stored for security reasons, e.g. to be able to clarify cases of misuse. If data has to be kept for evidentiary reasons, it is exempt from deletion until the incident has been finally clarified.

3 REACH MEASUREMENT & COOKIES

This website uses cookies for pseudonymised reach measurement, which are transmitted to the user's browser either from our server or the server [datenschutz.org](https://www.datenschutz.org) of third parties. Cookies are small files that are stored on your device. Your browser accesses these files. The use of cookies increases the user-friendliness and security of this website. Common browsers offer the setting option not to allow cookies.

It is not guaranteed that you will be able to access all the functions of this website without restrictions if you make appropriate settings.

4 GOOGLE ANALYTICS

This website uses the "Google Analytics" service, which is offered by Google Inc. (1600 Amphitheatre Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA) for the optimisation and analysis of our online offer within the meaning of Art. 6 (1) (1) (f) GDPR, due to our legitimate interests. The service (Google Analytics) uses "cookies" – text files that are stored on your device. The information collected by the cookies is usually sent to a Google server in the USA and stored there. 5 USES OF PERSONAL DATA AND LEGAL BASES

No registration is required for our website. So, you can visit our website without telling us who you are. We only collect and process access data that your internet browser automatically transmits to us

for technical reasons in order to provide the website. Depending on the access protocol used, the log record contains general information with the following contents: User ID, browser and platform. This data does not allow us to draw any conclusions about your person.

6 CONTACT REQUESTS

For contact requests, it may be necessary to provide your name, address, e-mail address, reason for contacting us and your message. We process and store the personal data provided during the contact request exclusively for the purpose of processing your request, answering it and contacting you. The legal basis for this collection, processing and use of your personal data is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b) GDPR.

7 DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA

We will not sell, share, or otherwise distribute your personal information to third parties, except in the manner described in this Privacy Policy. Furthermore, we are entitled to outsource the processing and use of your personal data in whole or in part to external service providers who act for us as processors in accordance with Art. 4 No. 8 GDPR (e.g. sub-suppliers, transport companies, shipping services...). Personal data may also be disclosed to third parties if we are required to do so by law, court order or official regulation, or if it is necessary to support criminal or judicial investigations or other legal investigations or proceedings, whether domestic or foreign.

8 DATA TRANSFERS TO THIRD COUNTRIES

Third countries are countries outside the European Union that do not have a level of data protection comparable to the data protection law of the European Union. As a rule, our external service providers process your personal data within the European Union (EU) or the contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area (EEA). However, in the event that your personal data is transferred to and processed by a service provider located in the third country, MUT will ensure the protection of your personal data by means of appropriate safeguards, such as the conclusion of standard data protection clauses or the EU-US Privacy Shield.

9 STORAGE DURATION

We will only store your personal data for as long as it is necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected or – if there are longer statutory retention periods – for the duration of the retention required by law. We will then delete your personal data.

10 YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

In accordance with applicable data protection law, you have the following rights in particular:

- Right to information, correction, deletion and restriction: You have the right to request information about your personal data stored by us at any time. When we process or use your personal data, we will take reasonable steps to ensure that your personal data is accurate and up-to-date for the purposes for which it was collected. In the event that your personal data is inaccurate or incomplete, you can request that this data be corrected. In addition, you

may have the right to request the deletion or restriction of the processing of your personal data, for example if, for example, there is no longer a legitimate business purpose for such processing in accordance with this data protection regulation or applicable law and legal retention obligations do not preclude further storage.

- Right to data portability: You may have the right to receive the personal data concerning you that you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to transmit this data to another controller.
- Right to object: You may have the right to object to the processing of your personal data on special grounds relating to your particular situation.
- Right to withdraw your consent: If you have consented to the collection, processing and use of your personal data, you can revoke your consent at any time with effect for the future, but without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent before its withdrawal. You can also object to the use of your personal data for the purposes of market and opinion research and advertising.
